We will begin our 29th Annual Fall Bus Tour on Saturday September 25th in Saskatoon, SK and travel west to the Battlefords area. This year, we will be focusing on events of the 1885 Resistance. Tour Itinerary

Your onboard host is Talina Cyr-Steenkamp, Executive Director of the SAS. You can contact her prior to and during the tour with any questions. In the Battlefords, we will be joined by a series of special guests to share their stories surrounding significant events in Saskatchewan's past. The following itinerary is a selection of some of the sites we will be visiting, but more will be added as research continues.

We will have lunch and two refreshment stops each day.

DAY 1: Saturday September 25th

We will be leaving at **8:00 a.m. sharp** from the Archaeology Centre (#1 - 1730 Quebec Ave., Saskatoon, SK). We will be traveling with *Reggie's Twilight Tours*.

non-smoking. Please observe all hotel signs and smoke only in designated areas.) Enjoy the hotel's indoor saltwater pool, hot tubs, fitness room, steam room and sauna. We will have a banquet and special presentation at the **Western Development Museum** on Saturday evening.

Day 2 will launch at **9:00 am** after a continental breakfast at our hotel.

REGISTRATION AND OTHER INFORMATION

Bus Tour Costs: \$269 per person based on single occupancy; or \$249 per person based on double occupancy; \$99 for children aged 7-17 (under 7 stay free, space permitting). **Add \$35 per seat for each non-SAS member. All prices include 5% GST.**

- Fees are payable in full upon registration. There is a non-refundable deposit of \$100 per seat. If you must cancel, you must do so by September 17th, 2010.
- All participants must agree to follow the SAS *Guidelines for Visiting Archaeological Sites* (call the Archaeology Centre or visit our website for these guidelines).
- The advertised itinerary is subject to road, weather and other conditions, and changes may be made by the tour director as necessary. As well, our tours usually visit more sites than are advertised in the brochure.
- Comfortable walking shoes should be worn. Bring a warm jacket, mittens and a hat in case the September weather is cool on one of our short hikes. Also, bring an insulated travel mug. Don't forget to bring your camera!
- Registration must be received on or before September 17th, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. **Seat and hotel room availability is limited for this trip!** However, you may phone until noon, September 22nd, 2010 to see if there have been any cancellations. All monies will be refunded by the SAS in the event of our cancellation of the tour, and registrants will be notified of this or any other eventuality in a timely fashion.
