## Tour Itinerary

We will begin our 30th Annual Fall Bus Tour on Saturday October 8th in Saskatoon, SK and travel south to Regina to pick up more passengers. We will return to Regina, then Saskatoon, by mid-afternoon on Monday October 10th. Please read ahead to learn about our exciting itinerary!

Your onboard host is Kim Cloutier, Acting Executive Director of the SAS. Throughout the weekend, we will hear stories about unique sites, recent discoveries and geological features. We are honoured to have Dr. Ernie Walker and Dr. Margaret Kennedy from the Archaeology and Anthropology Department at the University of Saskatchewan, and Frank McDougall (retired geologist) join us. ### DAY 1: Saturday October 8th

- **\*\* Due to limited hotel rooms, most of our registrants will have to share a room. Please let us know if you cannot share.**
- Fees are payable in full upon registration. There is a non-refundable deposit of \$100 per seat. If you must cancel, you must do so by September 30th, 2011.
- All participants must agree to follow the SAS Guidelines for Visiting Archaeological Sites (call the Archaeology Centre or visit our website for these guidelines).
- The advertised itinerary is subject to road, weather and other conditions, and changes may be made by the tour director as necessary. As well, our tours usually visit more sites than are advertised in the brochure.
- Comfortable walking shoes should be worn. Bring a warm jacket, mittens and a hat in case the October weather is cool. Also, bring an insulated travel mug. Don't forget to bring your camera!
- Registration must be received on or before September 30th, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. **Seat and hotel room availability is limited for this trip!** However, you may phone until noon, October 5th, 2011 to see if there have been any cancellations.
